The International Baccalaureate Organization later adopted ISCP as the IB Primary Years Program. This may be the moment to form another grassroots movement to design a relevant framework to serve our young people.

- Collaborative workshops facilitated by the creator of the IMPACT framework encourage participants to delve deeper into specific aspects of the framework and explore ways to integrate them into their curriculum.
- Interactive sessions where participants share their ideas, challenges, and potential solutions for implementing the IMPACT framework.
- The event aims to foster a spirit of collaboration and grassroots involvement to serve the needs of today's young people, preparing them for the challenges and opportunities of the future.
